Died in France 3rd December 1917

William was born about 1895 in Creete, County Galway. His mother was Mary Mulvihill who was the sole person to receive his effects on his death

On 28th March 1914, William joined Birmingham City Police as an 18-year - old miner. He served on the 'D' division, with warrant number 8465 and collar number D110. William resigned on 5th March 1917 to join the army which he did in Birmingham

William was wounded in action and succumbed to his injuries at 21 Casualty Clearing Station in Ytres, France

William is buried at Rocquigny-Equancourt Road British Cemetery, Manancourt, France. Grave VI E 6
